

North Naples Fire Prevention Bureau**June 22, 2001 FPB SOG 01-06****Fire Prevention Procedures for taking new construction inspections****The North Naples Fire Prevention Bureau inspection policy is as follows:**

1. If you call prior to 9 AM the inspection will be conducted on the next business day.
2. If the inspection is called in after 9 AM, the inspection will be conducted in 2 business days.
3. All permit numbers associated with the inspection(s) must also be called in at the time of the inspection. No inspections will be performed without the permit on site.
4. Times will be given for the following inspections:
 - A. Hood Suppression Systems
 - B. Alarms
 - C. Sprinkler Hydro- Choice of Morning or Afternoon
 - D. Underground Hydro- Choice of Morning or Afternoon
 - E. Hydrant Restraint Inspections will be done between 9 AM and 11 AM
 - F. Flow off Roof will be at 1 PM
5. All "Final" inspections will be scheduled together (i.e. building, sprinkler, alarm, U/G etc)
6. A 48 hour "Special notification" to the Fire Department must given for any alarm or sprinkler system inspection in a multi-story building (over 2 stories).
7. For sprinklers installed with CPVC pipe a "Rough Sprinkler" inspection must be called in prior to putting the heads on and calling in for the "Sprinkler Hydro" inspection. A rough sprinkler inspection and a sprinkler hydro can be done at the same time if the contractor uses caps and nipples instead of the sprinkler heads.
8. Time Specific requests: any request for time specific inspections shall be subject to availability.
This will also require advance notice of 2 business days and shall cost \$75.00 per inspection.
9. The same inspection will not be scheduled 2 days in a row.
